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BOARD SELF-EVALUATION

The members of the Board of Education shall conduct an annual self-evaluation to determine the degree to which they are meeting their responsibilities as Board members and the needs of their educational community. This self-evaluation shall be positive, frank and honest, and shall be used to establish priorities for action and specific goals and objectives to strengthen the operation of the board.

The Board shall use a multifaceted self-evaluation instrument.

Other Reasons:

It is a good idea to have a bylaw acknowledging the necessity for a Board to evaluate its own operations as well as those of the district. This may be done in tandem with the Board's evaluation of the Chief School Administrator. The community should know that the Board understands the nature of its function and strives to improve its performance.
