
UMDNJ Health Science Careers Fact Sheet



Who can take this course sequence? Any student who shows an interest in careers in a health-related or medical field. In previous years, students taking this class have shown interest in pursuing careers in medicine (doctor/nurse), forensic pathology, psychiatry, physician assistants and medical technicians.

How do students enrolled in this program earn college credits through UMDNJ? Students who wish to participate in the dual-credit program must successfully pass both the course offered at West Orange High School and the exam administered at the end of the school year by UMDNJ.

Can students attempt only the Anatomy & Physiology UMDNJ exam for credit? No. Passing the Dynamics of Health Care & Society UMDNJ exam is a requisite for earning credit for Anatomy & Physiology, either previously or concurrently.

Can students who fail the Dynamics of Health Care & Society UMDNJ exam still take Anatomy & Physiology at West Orange High School the following year? Yes, they can still enroll in the course. However, they will not be able to attempt the UMDNJ exam to possibly earn college credits.

Do students have to be participating in the UMDNJ program to be enrolled in these classes? No. Students may be interested in these classes as a science elective, but not to pursue credit.

Do students need to have a particular teacher in order to qualify for the dual-credit partnership with UMDNJ? Teachers need to be recognized and certified by UMDNJ in order for their students to earn college credit. Currently, students need to be scheduled with *Mrs. Franek* for Dynamics of Health Care & Society, and with *Mrs. Schultz* for Anatomy & Physiology.
