Integrated Acceleration Academics Grades 1-5

4 Weeks - In Person Instruction (August 2 - August 26, 2021)
Kelly Elementary School: Monday - Thursday 8:30am - 12:30pm

The Integrated Acceleration Academics Program will seek to build and reinforce content area knowledge in ELA and Math to address student learning gaps and enrich learning opportunities.

Students

This program is designed for incoming students in Grades 1-5 who are performing below grade level in ELA and Math and have been identified by student performance data and their teacher.

Recovery Summer Tutorials Grades 4-5

4 Weeks - In Person Instruction (August 2 - August 27, 2021)
Kelly Elementary School: Monday - Thursday 8:30am - 12:30pm

Recovery Summer Tutorials will provide direct one-on-one scaffolded instruction with a focus on specific identified learning gaps in ELA and Math using supplemental resources such as LLI, Number Worlds, i-Ready Systems, etc.

Students

This program is designed for students entering grades 4 and 5 who are two or more years below grade level.

ESL Summer Program, Grades 1-9

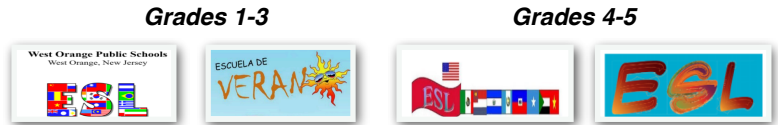
4 Weeks - In Person Instruction (June 28 - July 23, 2021)
West Orange High School: Monday - Thursday 8:30am - 12:15pm

Grades K-8 students will attend the Summer ESL program where they receive instruction in ESL and Math. Students will use the Fast ForWord program (K-5) iReady (6-8) as a supplement to target individualized learning needs.

ESL Summer Reinforcement, Grades 7-12

4 Weeks - Virtual Instruction (July 19 - August 23, 2021)
Virtual Instruction: Wednesdays 9am - 1pm (1 hour per student)

Weekly workshops with ELLs in grades 6-12 supporting students with Language acquisition development, iReady, ESL summer assignments that focus on the identified gaps and needs.

ELA Academic Support, Grade 6

4 Weeks - In Person Instruction (August 2 - August 26, 2021) Edison Central 6: Monday - Thursday 10am-12pm/12-2pm (2 hour time slots)

ELA Academic Support will provide targeted instruction in strengthening reading comprehension and/or foundational reading skills through small group instruction and personalized learning with an ELA 6 intervention teacher. Students will get a jumpstart to 6th grade by strengthening foundational reading skills and comprehension, reading with confidence and overall reading stamina!

The ELA 6 Academic Support Summer Program is for all incoming 6th grade students who received Basic Skills for language arts or Orton Gillingham reading support in grade 5.

Math Summer Support, Grades 6-12

4 Weeks - Virtual Instruction (1st week of July through 3rd week of August) Dates and times depend on the course. Detailed schedules shared via registration process.

Summer tutoring and instruction will be provided for students in 6-12 math courses to address identified key prerequisite concepts and skills. Teachers will provide one-on-one tutoring and/or small group instruction around key concepts required to enhance opportunities for success at the next level. Teachers will also monitor completion of assignments and provide support for the required summer assignments.

Middle School Summer Program, Grades 6-7

4 Weeks- In Person Instruction (June 28 - July 29, 2021)

Grade 6 (Edison) /Grade 7 (Roosevelt)

Monday - Thursday 9am-11:55am

The Middle School Summer Program will provide content recovery for the core subject areas of ELA, Math, Science and Social Studies for students seeking to be promoted to the next grade level. Select students will also receive an instructional block for developing Organizational Skills to further support their academic progress.

This program is designed for students who have failed two or more core courses and have been identified for possible retention.

The West Orange Summer Enrichment Program offers musical, artistic, and academic experiences which develop creativity, intellectual skills, and performing talents. Students may select courses that suit their abilities and interests. Secondary aged students participate in more advanced performing ensembles and courses in advanced artistic and musical concepts, as well as sophisticated academic classes.

Elementary aged students develop their basic musical, artistic, and academic skills. The Preparatory Division gives the student (entering grades 2 through 3) the opportunity to explore and discover a mix of musical, artistic, and fitness activities.
