WHEREAS, as a result of the above-referenced infractions, and considering all relevant factors, including the safe and orderly operation of the District and the best interests of both the student and the District, the Superintendent recommended that Student #1510086 be placed in an alternative educational environment for a period of one year;

WHEREAS, the student's parents were provided with timely and valid notice of the Superintendent's recommendation and their opportunity to present witnesses or evidence at a hearing before the West Orange Board of Education ("Board") at its meeting of September 15, 2025; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board hereby affirms the Superintendent's recommendation for placement of Student #1510086 in an alternative education placement, Roselle Park Academy/Essex Campus Academy, for a period of one year, subject to review after that period.

WHEREAS, the District received a report of an allegation of harassment, intimidation, and bullying ("HIB") against Student #2401050;

WHEREAS, the parent of the student was notified on or about August 20, 2025 that the allegation of HIB was unsubstantiated;

WHEREAS, the parent requested a hearing before the Board pursuant to N.J.S.A. 18A:37-15(b)(6)(d);

WHEREAS, at its meeting on September 15, 2025 the Board heard from the parent, the Superintendent, and school officials involved; and

WHEREAS, after considering the positions of the parents and the evidence presented by District Administration, the Board has determined to affirm the determination of the Superintendent.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the West Orange Board of Education, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 18A:37-15(b)(6)(e), hereby affirms the Superintendent's decision in the HIB matter involving Student #2401050.
