## **Integrated Acceleration Academics, Grades 1-5**

4 Weeks - In Person Instruction (July 31 - August 24, 2023)

Kelly Elementary School: Monday - Thursday 8:30am - 12:30pm

The Integrated Acceleration Academics Program will seek to build and reinforce content area knowledge in ELA and Math to address student learning gaps and enrich learning opportunities.

### **Students**

This program is designed for incoming students in grades 1-5 who are performing below grade level in ELA and Math and have been identified by student performance data and their teacher.

### **Registration**

Students invited to participate in the Integrated Acceleration Academics program will be notified via parent letter from district administration the week of June 5th with registration details.



## ESL Summer Program, Grades 1-9

4 Weeks - In Person Instruction (June 26 - July 21, 2023)

West Orange High School: Monday - Thursday 8:30am - 12:15pm

Grades 1-9 students will attend the Summer ESL program where they receive instruction in ESL and Math and utilize the Fast ForWord and iReady web based programs as a supplement to target individualized ELA, Math, and language acquisition learning needs. In addition, students receive enrichment opportunities in a variety of elective classes.

### Students

This program is open to English Language Learners entering grades 1-9 in the fall 2023.

### Registration

## Math Summer Support, Grades 6-12

4 Weeks – In Person and Virtual Instruction

(2nd week of July through 4th week of August)

Dates and times depend on the course. Detailed schedules shared via registration process.

Summer tutoring and instruction will be provided for students in 6-12 math courses to address identified key prerequisite concepts and skills. Teachers will provide one-on-one tutoring and/or small group instruction around key concepts required to enhance opportunities for success at the next level. Teachers will also monitor completion of assignments and provide support for the required summer assignments.

### Students

This program is open to all Math students that will enroll in the courses listed in the [Parent Letter and Registration Form](#), Grades 6-12.

## Career Education: Career Camp, Grades 6-9

1 Week - In Person Instruction (July 5 - 7, 2023)

WOHS: Wednesday - Friday 1:00pm - 4:00pm

Rising middle and high school students will explore the various career pathways they can experience as a student at WOHS through the Career and Technical Education Programs. Students will participate in hands-on activities, hear from industry experts and college professors and learn from alumni on how CTE courses have helped them advance their careers.

West Orange High School is implementing the fifth year of credit recovery for students with a final grade of an F in Algebra 1, Geometry, Algebra 2, College Math, all levels of English Language Arts, Social Studies, Science.

### Students

This program is designed for students in grades 9 – 12 who have failed one or more core-courses and are seeking credit recovery.

### Registration

The registration window for the WOHS Summer Institute 2023 is June 12 - June 23, 2023. Students must complete an online application by June 23rd and can enroll for a maximum of 15 credits (3 courses).

4 Weeks - Virtual Courses with In Person Support (June 26 - August 4, 2023)

### Students

This program is designed for students who have failed one or more core- courses and are seeking credit recovery through Educere.

### Registration

The registration window for the WOHS Summer Educere Supplemental Support is June 12 - June 23, 2023. Students must complete their online application by June 23rd. Course selections are to be completed with the guidance of the school counselor.

The SEL program is designed to help students with developing the social and emotional skills necessary to succeed in and out of the classroom. The SEL Program seeks to create a culture of social and emotional learning, develop self-awareness and self-management skills to achieve school and life success; support students in using social-awareness and interpersonal skills to establish and maintain positive relationships; develop decision-making skills and responsible behaviors in personal, school, and community contexts.

SEL workshop sessions will be held virtually or in-person as noted above, via small groups, bringing students into the building whenever possible.

4 Weeks In-Person Instruction (June 26 - July 21, 2023)

Monday - Friday 8:30am - 12:15pm

The West Orange Summer Enrichment Program offers musical, artistic, and academic experiences which develop creativity, intellectual skills, and performing talents. Students may select courses that suit their abilities and interests. Secondary aged students participate in more advanced performing ensembles and courses in advanced artistic and musical concepts, as well as sophisticated academic classes. Elementary aged students develop their basic musical, artistic, and academic skills. The Preparatory Division gives the student (entering grades 2 through 3) the opportunity to explore and discover a mix of musical, artistic, and fitness activities.
