Due to concern of mouse infestation, West Orange Board of Education reached out to the West Orange Health Department for assistance and verification that action is being taken to rid mouse problem in school.

Met with Robert Csigi, Director of Buildings and Grounds at Kelly Elementary School to perform a walk-thru of school grounds to check for mouse activity. Several methodologies have been already made to rid problem such as having Alliance Pest Services come and work with the school to close/ repair areas that may have permitted rodent entry into building. Alliance came last 02/14/2020 to place 450 snap traps and monitoring traps throughout the school and are on call if any sighting or trap is set off by mice. Several tamper resistant bait boxes were also placed on exterior of building around foundation. Routine pest control is monthly. Mr. Csigi states, yesterday approximately 6 mice and babies were caught in traps and discarded immediately. ServPro was then called to take immediate action and entire school floors-classrooms, kitchen, food storage, nurses office etc. were cleaned and sanitized Tuesday night 02/18/2020. Additionally, furniture was moved in classrooms so ServPro could clean behind them.

During walk thru, several areas (classrooms, kitchen areas, storage rooms, library, art room, restrooms, basement level areas) were inspected for mouse activity and most rooms was found to be clean/sanitary. Classrooms #123, #108 and Art room did have a small amount of mouse droppings observed along floor wall borders and in drawers of Art room. Amount of droppings observed was very minimal and will be cleaned and sanitized today. Fan exhaust in Art room may be permitting rodents entry into building, so Mr. Csigi and Alliance Pest Services came up with a solution of retrofitting a box with mesh on the exterior of the building to prevent rodents from getting inside through the fan. This is planned on being corrected this week. All windows on ground level of school have been installed with metal mesh. All holes on interior of building have been previously repaired and sealed with steal wool and foam. All doors have been weatherstripped within the last 2 years.

Boiler Room and water meter room have a small amount of old rodent droppings and nesting material on the ground/ floor wall borders that need to get cleaned up and sanitized. Area is also scheduled to be cleaned this week.

Overall, walk thru inspection provided verification that school is found to be in a clean and sanitary state. Aggressive efforts have been made and a continued response to take action to rid mouse issue is evident.
