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Attendance



- Notes- have only two days to bring in a note. Email notes to wohsattendance@westorangeschools.org
- Number of absences allowed – **Semester 8 and Full Year 17**- Only Hospital visits, **Doctor's Notes (bring to the Nurse)** and Religious days are waived
- Cut policy and loss of credit- 3 Cuts
- No Loitering in the building
 - Go directly to your approved destination
 - **Don't be late to classes - Detentions will be assigned by teachers/Deans**
 - Allowed out for bathroom up to 10 minutes

Important updates



- SMART PASS - accessed by your cell phone.
- ID's MUST be in possession at all times, teachers should bring class to security to get pictures if they have not done so already
 - You will need an ID for lunches, riding the bus, school events, and to use the bathrooms
- Electronic Device Policy- not responsible for lost or stolen items
- Lockers- are assigned by request only at Security Office - must present lock to get locker
 - You Are Responsible for What's in the locker
- Chromebooks - ONLY use your assigned chromebooks, using someone else's chromebook can be considered Theft!
- HIB- Harassment/Intimidation/Bullying- WOHS will not tolerate any form of HIB. Cyberbullying (Facebook, Twitter, Instagram, etc...) has become a serious concern of ours.
- Every student has a gmail account and should be checking it on a **daily basis**



Important Rules and Consequences

- Dress Code
 - Updated recently - basic principle that certain body parts must be covered for all students at all times.
 - Student cannot wear hats, hoods, visors, sweatbands, bandanas/flags, wave caps, do-rags and all other non-religious headgear are strictly prohibited and may not be worn in school. Additionally, combs or hair picks, etc. may not be worn during the school day.
 - Sunglasses may not be worn in school.
 - Pants and shorts must be fastened at the waist so that undergarments are not intentionally exposed
 - See-through garments, bustiers, tops with cut outs or shirts that allow the midriff to be overly exposed
- Fighting- 1st Offense and 2nd Offense
 - “Engage” know how to walk away
 - Conflict Resolution- see any staff member before it escalates, go to Restorative Practice Center for help navigating arguments or tension amongst other students!

Discipline Consequence Levels



- Discipline- Discuss Various levels 1-9 (pgs. 23-26 in student handbook)
 - General detention
 - Extended detention (Wednesdays)
 - Saturday detention (3 hours),
 - Restorative Practice Day/Session
 - ISS - In School Suspension
 - Out of school suspension- (can range up to 10 days)

***missing a general it becomes and extended, if you miss your extended it becomes a Saturday detention,
