CONNECTING WITH THE SCHOOL COUNSELORS

DURING VIRTUAL LEARNING

During the closure of schools, the West Orange Public Schools/School Counseling Department will be operating virtually. School Counselors and Student Assistance Counselors (SACs) are available through email and voicemail. Over the next two weeks the school counselors will be providing a schedule of virtual meetings where students will sign up and/or participate. These meetings will be conducted individually or in small groups. The schedule will be provided through Naviance and Google Classroom.

School counselors and Student Assistance Counselors (SACs) will be checking and responding to their voicemails and emails from home daily. Email is the best avenue to reach the school counselor. To schedule an appointment, students and parents may email the assigned School Counselor or SAC directly to determine a mutually agreed upon date, time and platform (ZOOM; Google Meets; Phone conference; in person).



THE ELKS NATIONAL FOUNDATION 2021 MOST VALUABLE STUDENT SCHOLARSHIP

Hispanic Heritage Foundation Youth Awards

The Youth Awards was founded in 1998 by the Hispanic Heritage Foundation. Now entering its 22nd year, the Youth Awards honors Latino high school seniors who excel in the classroom and community and for their excellence in various categories including: Business & Finances, Entrepreneurship, Education, Healthcare & Science, Media & Entertainment, Sports and Technology. Applicant must be of Hispanic heritage (includes Spain, Brazil, Philippines)

Gold, Silver and Bronze recipients are selected in each category and receive a one-time grant to fund their college education or to fund a community service effort that tackles a social issue.

Application Deadline December 6, 2020

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APIA (Asian and Pacific Islander American Scholarship Fund)

The nation's largest non-profit organization devoted to providing college scholarships for Asian Americans and Pacific Islanders (AAPI).

Scholarship awards range from one-time \$2,500 awards to multi-year \$20,000 awards. APIA Scholars provides scholarships to underserved APIA students with a special focus on those who:

- **Live at or below the poverty level, or are otherwise of low socioeconomic status;
- **Are the first in their families to attend college;
- **Are representative of the APIA community's diversity, (geographically and ethnically), especially those
- ethnicities that have been underrepresented on college campuses due to limited access and opportunity. **Have placed a strong emphasis on community service and leadership as well as solid academic.

HOW TO APPLY

The APIA Scholarship Program application must be completed online and submitted electronically once all of the required questions have been answered.

The application will be available for the 2021-22 academic year from September 9,2020, until January 14, 2021, at 5:00 PM EST.

Jefferson Scholars

The Jefferson Scholarship is the premier undergraduate scholarship at the University of Virginia. Scholars are selected through a rigorous selection process that is based on exceptional performance in the areas of leadership, scholarship and citizenship. The award is intended to cover the entire cost of attendance for four years at the University of Virginia plus coverage of the supplemental enrichment experiences. Only one student may be nominated from West Orange HS. Nominations are completed by both school officials and students and include a scholastic report, extracurricular activities, recommendation letters and two essays. All counselors and Jefferson Scholar nominees must complete the nomination form by December 1, 2020

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Pureland Supply Vocational and Skilled Trade Scholarship

The \$500.00 Pureland Supply Scholarship is available to students who have been accepted to an accredited trade school, vocational college, technical school or community college for the study of trade, craft, or labor occupations. Virtual BTSN

- The evening will be synchronous and parents/guardians will, as in the past, follow their child's schedule and briefly meet each teacher.
- Period 1 begins at 7pm. Classes will be 10 minutes with 5 minutes "passing time."
- There will be pre-recorded welcome messages from Mr. Moore, Principal, as well as the PTA President that will be made available at 6:30pm. Links will be embedded on one <u>BTSN template</u> that the student will complete for parents/guardians.

Teachers

- Teachers have created Zoom links for each period they teach.
- The Zoom links have been shared with students via Google Classroom.
- Students were given time and instructed by their teachers to copy the link into the BTSN template.

Students

- Each student will fill out one BTSN template that has the links for all of their classes.
- Students will share the BTSN template with their parents or guardians by Monday, October 5th.
- Students will log their parents into their district account OR share their district login name and password with their parents.

Parents

- Parents please check to make sure that students have completed the BTSN template for you by Monday, October 5th.
- For security purposes, parents must log on to the system and access the Zoom links using the student's login and password. Each student's district account must be authenticated by the system in order to have access to the Zoom links. (The links will not work from any account. Parents' only option is to access the links via the student's login and password.)
- Parents/guardians can login to the student's account simultaneously from separate locations.
- If a parent or guardian does not have the opportunity to see the teachers live, please email the teacher and they will provide the information.
