

so, 85% of garment workers are paid below minimum wage means only 15% of garment workers get paid properly for all the hard labor they do.

time of the year which would make us able to connect with the dead.




Top Ten Google secrets!

1. The True Answer to Life, the Universe, and Everything



3. Everything's Askew!




Askew means not in a straight line or level position. But if you are to search up the word askew, guess what happens. The search engine will tilt the screen for you. This is one of the display Easter eggs that





6. "Mom! The Festivus pole is sticking out on my google search page again!"




cialism of the Christmas season.

7. The Sonic Easter Egg





This is one of the amazing Google easter eggs. Click <u>here</u> and along with a mind-blowing calculus, you will see a spinning egg in 3D.


10. LGBT




DIY Doughnut Earrings

Make your very own doughnut earrings by following the simple step by step instructions.

The following materials are needed for this DIY:

- Keychain rings
- Brush
- Eye pins
- Acrylic paints
- Clay
- Modge Podge



Step 5. Insert your eye pins into the top and bottom of the donut, Until nothing but the circle is showing, Then let it dry.



Step 6. Get some more clay and make it into a line, then paint it black and cut it into little pieces. (these will be the sprinkles)



Step 7. Add the sprinkles to the doughnut.



Step 8. Then add them to your donut and add bits of Mod Podge to



the top of the donut.







INSTRUCTIONS

Step 1. Flatten your clay into a donut shape, then use your tool and insert your tool into the now flattened clay.



Step 2. Paint your donut a polish color.



Step 3. Then mix your two colors, any colors, to make the icing for the donut. Apply it to the top of the donut.



Step 4. Cut your eye pins halfway, then twist it in the shape of an earring.
