Transportation Guidelines

- Middle School Students living **at least 2.0 miles** from school are eligible for busing.
- Students who live on **designated hazardous** roads are eligible for busing even if they do not meet the state mileage requirements.
- Students with IEPs are eligible for transportation services as specified in their IEP.
- Students should arrive at bus stop at least ten minutes before pick-up time.
- Students shows bus pass to driver and boards bus.
- Students can only ride their **designated bus**.
- A student will only be picked up/dropped off at the stop designated on Bus Pass.
- Driver only makes designated stop.

Practice School Bus Safety every day by reminding students of these rules:

- Stand only in the designated school bus stop.
- Keep the aisle clear and stay in your seat
- Use seat belts.
- No Horseplay.
- The Bus Driver is in full charge of the bus and responsible for maintaining order.

IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS FOR GRADE 6

- In accordance with the NJ State Department of Health and Senior Services, all children born on or after January 1, 1997 shall have received one dose of Tdap (Tetanus, diphtheria, acellular pertussis) and one dose of a meningococcal (Menactra) vaccine.
- These vaccines are given when your child turn 11 years old and, are required before they start 6th grade in September. If your child turn 11 during their 6th grade school year, the immunizations will be required at that time. Proof of vaccination, documented by your child's doctor, need to be submitted to the school nurse by the first day of school.



MEDICATIONS AT SCHOOL

• All medication including over the counter medication, can only be administered by the school nurse with a physician's order. The medication must be in the original box with your child's name on the pharmacy label. This must be accompanied by the physician and parent medication forms. The physician and the parent medication forms are on the school's website or can be obtained from the nurse's office.

The West Orange Board of Education is pleased to announce the **Aftercare Program** at Thomas A. Edison Middle School. This program will be held at Thomas A. Edison Middle School. This is an opportunity for our students to participate in worthwhile activities supervised by teachers and staff members.

The Aftercare Program allows parents an opportunity to pick up their child later in the day. Students will begin the program in the cafeteria where they will have a snack provided from home, and an opportunity to begin homework. Students will then proceed to the gymnasium with the option of participating in a sport/activity. Lastly, students will then go to the library where they will start homework and then have an opportunity to use the computers. This program will run Monday-Friday from 2:53pm – 6:00pm. No late buses are provided at 6:00pm. Parents must pick-up their child from the library at Edison Middle School. If a parent is picking up their child before 4:30 pm, they must knock on the outside gymnasium back door.

Program Schedule:

- 2:53 3:30 Sign in, snack, & homework
- 3:30 4:30 Planned activities in the gymnasium
- 4:30 5:30 Homework and computer time
- 5:30 6:00 Parent pick-up in the LMC
- *Before 4:30 p.m. parent pick-up in the gymnasium



The aftercare program fee will be a flat rate of \$200 a month regardless of how many days you would like your child to attend. <u>Checks are due the first Friday of each month</u>. Please make all checks payable to The West Orange Board of Education.
