
Dear Student and Parent:

We are two weeks away from transitioning to our hybrid or 25% capacity in-person learning phase. We hope that your E-learning has been engaging and meaningful for your child to this point. We are hopeful our local community maintains low levels of COVID activity to enable our successful move to face to face instruction! We believe our teachers have established effective school routines, your child has adjusted to "normal" school hours and are school-focused in completing after-hour assignments and homework.

Our hybrid opening of school will require some expectations and requirements noted below:

- Virtual students (off day hybrid and parent selected all virtual) will continue to log on to Zoom meetings during their class session and interact with Google Classroom activities which would count as students being present. Any Google Classroom class period assignments must be submitted on the day assigned.
- Teachers will continue to Zoom live stream lessons to those at home while co-working more closely with the in-person learners. Key lesson segments whereby direct teaching of content will continue to be recorded and posted in your child's content area Google Classroom. Missing the live-stream will inhibit asking real-time questions.
- There are some in-person expectations that need to be communicated:
 - Masks must be worn at all times. School personnel will practice this same safety practice.
 - Sanitizer wipes and hand sanitizer will be available in all classrooms with students wiping down desks prior to leaving the classroom.
 - o Bathroom breaks are encouraged during the 10 minutes between classes. Staff will monitor bathroom traffic permitting two students in at a time and recording names and times.
 - Morning Drop Off: students exit buses and parent drop-off moving to their alphabetical entry whereby temperature screening and social distancing within the school entry area will be monitored. (see image)



- Dismissal will be staggered and exits varied to ensure social distancing at the end of the school day. Public
 address announcements will be made during Advisory for walkers, pick-ups, and specific bus route arrivals for
 students to be dismissed.
- o NO late buses will be available. Parents, please communicate clearly with your child and notify the school if they are a bus traveler and you intend to pick them up.
- Lockers will not be used, students will be permitted to carry backpacks and are not allowed to share their personal belongings.
- Students will be provided with "grab and go" lunch at the conclusion of the school day. Students qualifying for free and reduced lunch will also be provided with breakfast for the following day at the same time.
- O Bus Travel masks required at all times with students assigned seating. Those boarding first will be seated in the back of the bus, with the bus disembarked in reverse order of boarding.
- Emergency Drills and Fire Drills the State of NJ will continue to require bi-monthly emergency drill practice
 with one monthly fire drill and one other emergency drill. COVID protocols have been established to avoid
 building-wide evacuations or creating close contact between students.
- In-person teaching with small groupings will be based upon last name alphabetical cohorts noted below:
 - Cohort A Last names A D
 - Cohort B Last names E K
 - Cohort C Last names L Q
 - Cohort D Last names R Z
- Our 4-hour school day will follow the schedule below:
