Dear parents/guardians of Roosevelt Middle School/Liberty Middle School students:

**Health forms should be submitted to the school nurse in your building prior to or at the beginning of each school year. New forms are required every school year.** Please feel free to contact the school nurse with any questions or concerns. Thank you in advance for your cooperation!

- For students with asthma (this form **must** be completed for a student to be allowed to self-carry their asthma inhaler in school):

*The form must be completed by **both** a physician and a parent/guardian. Please use a separate form for each medication. Any medications for in school use must be dropped off by a parent/guardian in the original packaging. Medications without the original packaging cannot be accepted. Medication without the required medication form cannot be accepted.*

  - Sports forms must be submitted annually. Completed sport forms by your healthcare provider must be in school prior to the 1st week of school start in September or in school the 1st week of September for evaluation and signed approval by school physician Dr. M. Kelly. Further instructions are on the sports packet.
  - If the student has any medical concerns, additional documentation may be requested. Students with asthma or life-threatening allergies will be required to have the appropriate additional paperwork and medication with them in order to participate.

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
