School Counseling Office Information

Dean of Students Information

Attendance: Student attendance is extremely important and directly related to achievement. We have attendance regulations for all WOHS students posted on our website and in our electronic Student Handbook. Students risk losing credit for courses if they exceed the number of acceptable absences or accumulate three or more "cuts". Our policy specifically states that a student may not exceed a total of 18 chargeable absences for a full course or 9 chargeable absences for a semester course.

Senior Lunches: Only Seniors are offered the privilege of leaving campus at lunch time when the bell rings at 10:23 AM.
