

Our Vision: The Collection

The West Orange Library Media Program continually updates the collections in both print and digital formats which builds on the concept of windows, sliding glass doors and mirrors.

"Books are sometimes <u>windows</u>, that may be real or imagined, familiar or strange. These windows are also <u>sliding glass doors</u>, and readers have only to walk through in imagination to become part of whatever world has been created or recreated by the author. When lighting conditions are just right, however, a window can also be a <u>mirror</u>. Literature transforms human experience and reflects it back to us, and in that reflection we can see our own lives and experiences as part of a larger human experience. Reading, then, becomes a means of self-affirmation, and readers often seek their mirrors in books."

- → Bookcases could not be reused
 - ♦ There since 1997
 - Shelves in center were separating due to warping and are held together with metal rods
 - Bookcases stationary
- → Storage space is very limited
 - ♦ Room in back of library repurposed
- → Computers outdated-will reduce number and update.
- → Circulation desk over 25 years old
 - Little storage
 - Awkward location
- → Carpet over 25 years old and sustained damage
- → Makerspace needs designated location for students and storage
- → Student lounge area for relaxed reading missing
- → Tables and chairs very heavy and difficult to move
- → Collection: weeding and inventory allows for new additions based on analysis to promote collection vision
- → Smart Board not mounted and took up a lot of floor space

Makerspaces require flexibility, versatility, and storage.

By establishing a designated space for makers, we'll enter a new era of making.



Students will have easy access to materials which fuel creative problem solving, and groups can work on projects over time in a secure environment.

- → Comfortable and flexible seating
- → Space for various purposes
 - ◆ School-wide Events; Global Read Aloud, Author Visits
 - Meetings, virtual field trips, celebrations, Kindergarten orientations, and....

 - Bookcases on wheels
- → More floor space with mounted smart board
- → Much more storage space for media specialist
- → Community use of space






