XII. WEST ORANGE BOARD OF EDUCATION RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING EXECUTIVE SESSION

WHEREAS, while the "Sen. Byron M. Baer Open Public Meetings Act" (N.J.S.A. 10:4-6 <u>et seq</u>.) requires all meetings of the West Orange Board of Education to be held in public, N.J.S.A. 10:4-12(b) sets forth nine (9) types of matters that may lawfully be discussed in "Executive Session," without the public being permitted to attend, and

WHEREAS, the Board has determined that four (4) issues are permitted by N.J.S.A. 10:4-12(b) to be discussed without the public in attendance and shall be discussed during an Executive Session to be held on Monday, February 24, 2020, and

WHEREAS, the nine (9) exceptions to open public meetings set forth in N.J.S.A. 10:4-12(b) are listed below, and next to each exception is a box which will be marked when the issues to be privately discussed fall within that exception, and after each exception is a space where additional information that will disclose as much information about the discussion as possible without undermining the purpose of the exception shall be written:

"(1) Any matter which, by express provision of Federal law, State statute or rule of court shall be rendered confidential or excluded from public discussion." The nature of the matter, described as specifically as possible without undermining the need for confidentiality is:

 \square "(2) Any matter in which the release of information would impair a right to receive funds from the federal government." The nature of the matter, described as specifically as possible without undermining the need for confidentiality is:

"(3) Any material the disclosure of which constitutes an unwarranted invasion of individual privacy such as any records, data, reports, recommendations, or other personal material of any educational, training, social service, medical, health, custodial, child protection, rehabilitation, legal defense, welfare, housing, relocation, insurance and similar program or institution operated by a public body pertaining to any specific individual admitted to or served by such institution or program, including but not limited to information relative to the individual's personal and family circumstances, and any material pertaining to admission, discharge, treatment, progress or condition of any individual, unless the individual concerned (or, in the case of a minor or incompetent, his guardian) shall request in writing that the same be disclosed publicly." The nature of the matters, described as specifically as possible without undermining the need for confidentiality are: _____.

■ "(4) Any collective bargaining agreement, or the terms and conditions of which are proposed for inclusion in any collective bargaining agreement, including the negotiation of terms and conditions with employees or representatives of employees of the public body." The collective bargaining contract discussed is between the Board and WOAA and a matter concerning the terms and conditions of Local 68.

 \Box "(5) Any matter involving the purchase, lease or acquisition of real property with public funds, the setting of banking rates or investment of public funds where it could adversely affect the public interest if discussion of such matters were disclosed." The nature of the matter, described as specifically as possible without undermining the need for confidentiality is:

 \Box "(6) Any tactics and techniques utilized in protecting the safety and property of the public, provided that their disclosure could impair such protection. Any investigations of violations or possible violations of the law." The nature of the matter, described as specifically as possible without undermining the need for confidentiality is:

 \Box "(7) Any pending or anticipated litigation or contract negotiation in which the public body is, or may become a party. Any matters falling within the attorney-client privilege, to the extent that confidentiality is required in order for the attorney to exercise his ethical duties as a lawyer." The parties to and docket numbers of each item of litigation and/or the parties to each contract discussed are and the nature of the discussion, described as specifically as possible without undermining the need for confidentiality are:

■ "(8) Any matter involving the employment, appointment, termination of employment, terms and conditions of employment, evaluation of the performance, promotion or disciplining of any specific prospective public officer or employee or current public officer or employee employed or appointed by the public body, unless all individual employees or appointees whose rights could be adversely affected request in writing that such matter or matters be discussed at a public meeting." Subject to the balancing of the public's interest and the employee's privacy rights under South Jersey Publishing Co. v. New Jersey Expressway Authority, 124 N.J. 478 (1991), the employee(s) and nature of the discussion, described as specifically as possible without undermining the need for confidentiality are Employee Numbers #8546 and #8520.

 \square "(9) Any deliberation of a public body occurring after a public hearing that may result in the imposition of a specific civil penalty upon the responding party or the suspension or loss of a license or permit belonging to the responding party as a result of an act of omission for which the responding party

bears responsibility." The nature of the matter, described as specifically as possible without undermining the need for confidentiality is:

WHEREAS, the length of the Executive Session is estimated to be thirty (30) minutes after which the public meeting of the Board shall (select one) \blacksquare reconvene and immediately adjourn or \square reconvene and proceed with business where formal action will be taken.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the West Orange Board of Education will go into Executive Session for the above stated reasons only; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board hereby declares that its discussion of the aforementioned subject(s) will be made public at a time when the public's interest in disclosure is greater than any privacy or governmental interest being protected from disclosure.

GRADUATION EVENT CONTRACT

LICENSE AGREEMENT dated as of <u>FEBRUARY 4, 2020</u> between the COUNTY OF ESSEX, a body corporate and politic of the State of New Jersey, with its principle office located at the Hall of Records, Newark, New Jersey and <u>WEST</u> <u>ORANGE HIGH SCHOOL</u> having its offices at <u>51 Conforti Avenue, West</u> <u>Orange, NJ 07052</u>.

WHEREAS, Licensee desires to use Rink # 1 at the South Mountain Recreation Complex Essex County Codey Arena owned by the County (the "Licensed Premises") for conduction of their graduation commencement exercises on TUESDAY JUNE 23, 2020 and the County is agreeable to license such use upon the terms and conditions hereinafter set forth:

NOW THEREFORE, it is agreed as follows:

The County hereby grants Licensee the right to use the Licensed Premises on **TUESDAY JUNE 23, 2020** for the setup/rehearsal/graduation ceremony/clean-up ("Event"). All scheduled times must be strictly adhered to:

- <u>SET-UP</u>: (Day of the event) School Maintenance Staff is responsible for the set-up of all floor plans designed by the school including chairs, tables, audio, and video equipment.
- <u>**REHEARSAL</u>**: Scheduled accordingly <u>*during the day of the ceremony*</u> ~ *Buses must drop off students and return for pick-up.*</u>
- **<u>GRADUATION</u>**: 6pm or later ~ Due to daily functions within the complex, parking and staffing, *all ceremonies must be scheduled at <u>6pm or later</u>.*
- <u>CLEAN-UP</u>: (Conclusion of ceremony) ~ School Maintenance Staff is responsible following the commencement to remove any <u>school items</u> <u>and/or rented materials</u> provided or designated by the school. The stands and arena floor must be checked for any school items. The arena is NOT responsible for materials left behind by the school.
 - ARENA STAFF will handle the clean-up of the lobby, bathrooms and locker rooms.

Licensee shall pay a license fee of Six Thousand Dollars (\$6,000.00) inclusive of a One Thousand Dollar (\$1000.00) refundable security deposit toward potential damages caused by the Licensee Event which will include surrounding areas inside and outside of the licensed premises and property. If additional damages or costs in excess of One Thousand Dollars (\$1000.00) are incurred, the licensee will be billed for those repair services incurred on the date of the Event.

The security deposit will be refunded by the County if Licensee performs care to the standards and satisfaction of the County. The License Fee shall be payable in the following manner:

- Two separate one thousand dollar checks (\$1,000.00) will be submitted with \$1,000 <u>as a non-refundable deposit</u> and \$1,000 <u>being returned</u> <u>after the graduation</u> upon the execution by Licensee of this Agreement.
- The final payment of four thousand dollars (\$4,000.00) *will be paid 45 days prior to the scheduled event*.
- Separate signed contract for security and total cost as determined by the Essex County Sheriff's Department will be handled by the school and the Essex Sheriff's Dept.
- An additional fee of <u>\$175.00</u> (paid separate check) for the use of the main video screen inside the arena must be contracted thru management staff at the facility. No outside personnel will be allowed to use the facility video board equipment inside the facility.

The following facilities and services at the "Licensed Premises" are included in the license fee:

- Use of Rink #1
- Use of a maximum of 4 locker rooms
- Use of 3 party rooms
- Use of the parking facilities as determined by the E.C. South Mtn. Recreation Complex
- Use of the sound system
- Use of chairs to be set up by the school personnel staff (limited quantity 500)
- Use of hallway and lobby for procession

Security Arrangements for the Event and pre and post Event activities, including all law enforcement and other security personnel cost are the responsibility of the Licensee. All provisions shall be made by the Licensee through the Essex County Sheriff's Department, contact person will be supplied. The Essex County Sheriff's Department will determine the quantity of security personnel needed for such Event.

Licensee will obtain at its cost and expense any and all (additional) licenses or permits necessary for holding the Event.

No signs, pictures, notices or advertisements shall be inscribed, painted or affixed by the Licensee upon any part of the Licensed Premises without the prior written consent of the County. The Licensee must make written public notice to all graduates/parents/grandparents/guests *before* the "Event". <u>Please note</u>:

• NO BALLOONS are allowed in the arena or lobby area.

• No food or drinks can be brought into the Arena during the event.

Licensee shall comply with all statutes, ordinances, rules, regulations and requirements of the Federal, State, County and Municipal Government and their agencies, departments and bureaus applicable to the Licensed Premises and the Event at the Licensee's cost and expense. If Licensee fails to comply therewith, the County may, at its option, cancel the Event or do and perform any of such acts in order to comply therewith, at the cost and expense of the Licensee, which cost and expense shall be deemed an additional fee and collected as such.

Licensee shall make no alteration, repair or improvement to the Licensed Premises without the prior written consent of the County thereto.

Licensee agrees that if the Licensed Premises are damaged by fire or any other cause whatsoever, so as to prevent the holding of the Event in the opinion of the County, then the County, at its option, may cancel the Event and terminate this License Agreement and all rights and privileges of Licensee hereunder shall thereupon cease.

Licensee shall immediately after the termination of the Event, remove from the Licensed Premises all of its personal property, goods, chattels and effects, and on failure to do so, Licensee hereby authorizes the County to consider said property, goods, chattels and effects abandoned by the Licensee and to dispose of said property in any manner whatsoever without incurring any liability therefore.

Licensee agrees that no representation as to the condition of the Licensed Premises has been made by the County, and that the Licensee has made a thorough inspection thereof and relies wholly on said inspection and agrees to accept same in the condition existing on the date hereof. Licensee further agrees to keep the Licensed Premises in good repair and safe condition at its own cost and expense and at the expiration of the Event to leave said premises in as good condition as when received.

Licensee agrees to protect, defend, indemnify and hold harmless the County and its officials, employees, and agents from and against any and all losses, penalties, damages, settlements, costs, charges, professional fees or other expenses or liabilities of every kind and character arising out of or relating to any and all claims, liens, demands, obligations, actions, proceedings or causes of action of every kind and character in connection with or arising directly or indirectly out of this License Agreement and/or the Event, included but not limited to claims of any nature whatsoever of participants, spectators, or persons working at the Event.

Licensee shall provide General Liability Insurance, including Broad Form Property Damage and Personal Injury Coverage in the amount of not less than \$1,000,000.00 Combined Single Limit applicable to Bodily Injury and Property Damage. A Certificate of Insurance evidencing such insurance shall be filed with the County at least four weeks prior to the Event. The County shall be named as an Additional Named Insured for liability coverage under the Licensee's liability insurance policy.

The County, its officers, servants, agents and employees shall at all times have free access to the Licensed Premises during the Event.

Licensee hereby expressly waives any and all claims for compensation for loss or damage sustained by reason of any defect, deficiency or impairment of any of the utilities at the Licensed Premises, and hereby releases and discharges the County and its officers, employees, and agents from any and all demands, claims, actions and causes of action arising there from.

Licensee shall not use or permit the storage on the Licensed Premises of any hazardous substance or explosives or of any material or substance prohibited by State, County, or Municipal law, regulation, or policy.

Nothing herein contained shall create or be construed as creating, a joint venture or partnership between the County and Licensee, or to constitute Licensee as an agent of the County.

The maximum number of participants in and spectators at the Event shall be limited to <u>3,500 including the chairs on the rink area</u>. It is further agreed that <u>all seating plans shall be submitted to the County for approval 30 days</u> <u>prior to</u>

<u>the event</u>. Under no circumstances will seating be allowed that will jeopardize viewing by others, cause spectator discomfort or violate State, County, or local fire laws.

No agreement for television or radio coverage can be entered into by Licensee without the prior written consent of the County.

The sale of food, beverages, novelties and souvenirs at any location in the South Mountain Recreation Complex shall be limited to the County, and Licensee shall have no interest therein. If Licensee desires to sell any items not offered by the County or its authorized agent, written approval 30 days in advance must be approved by the Director of the Department of Parks, Recreation and Cultural Affairs. <u>A vendor fee of \$75.00 will be charged per vendor</u>. Operations must be set up outside the arena and not blocking any doors or fire exits.

This Agreement may not be amended except by a written instrument executed by each of the parties hereto.

This Agreement constitutes the entire understanding of the parties hereto with respect to the subject matter hereof, and supersedes any and all prior understandings or agreements, oral or written, with respect thereto.
