Integrated Acceleration Academics, Grades 1-5

4 Weeks - In Person Instruction (July 29 - August 22, 2024)
Kelly Elementary School: Monday - Thursday 8:30am - 12:30pm

The Integrated Acceleration Academics Program will seek to build and reinforce content area knowledge in ELA and Math to address student learning gaps and enrich learning opportunities.

Students

This program is designed for incoming students in grades 1-5 who are performing below grade level in ELA and Math and have been identified by student performance data and their teacher.

Registration

Students invited to participate in the Integrated Acceleration Academics program will be notified via parent letter from district administration the week of May 15th with registration details.



ESL Summer Program, Grades 1-9

4 Weeks - In Person Instruction (June 24 - July 19, 2024)
West Orange High School: Monday - Friday 8:30am - 12:15pm

Grades 1-9 Multilingual learners will attend the Summer ESL program where they receive instruction in ESL and Math and utilize the Fast ForWord and iReady web based programs as a supplement to target individualized ELA, Math, and language acquisition learning needs. In addition, students receive enrichment opportunities in a variety of elective classes.

Students

This program is open to Multilingual Learners (MLs) entering grades 1-9 in the Fall 2024.

Registration

Parents register through their child's ESL teacher or by contacting Mr. Felix Plata at fplata@westorangeschools.org. Registration began on March 1st 2024 and closes May 3, 2024. Parents will be notified by June 1st regarding their child's acceptance to the program.



ENGLISH AS A SECOND LANGUAGE

Math Summer Support, Grades 6-12

4 Weeks - In Person and Virtual Instruction

(2nd week of July through 4th week of August)

Dates and times depend on the course. Detailed schedules shared via registration process.

Summer tutoring and instruction will be provided for students in 6-12 math courses to address identified key prerequisite concepts and skills. Teachers will provide one-on-one tutoring and/or small group instruction around key concepts required to enhance opportunities for success at the next level. Teachers will also monitor completion of assignments and provide support for the required summer assignments.

Students

This program is open to all Math students that will enroll in the courses listed in the [Parent Letter and Registration Form](#), Grades 6-12.

Career Education: Career Camp, Grades 6-9

1 Week - In Person Instruction (July 8 - 11, 2024)

WOHS: Monday - Thursday 1:00pm - 4:00pm

Rising middle and high school students will explore the various career pathways they can experience as a student at WOHS through the [Career and Technical Education \(CTE\) Programs](#). Students will participate in hands-on activities, hear from industry experts and college professors, tour the facilities, and learn from alumni on how CTE courses have helped them advance their careers.

Students

This program is designed for students who would like to learn about the various CTE Programs and career pathways available at WOHS. Students will leave with a better understanding of how the opportunities at WOHS prepare them for successful careers

WOHS Summer Institute, Grades 9-12

4 Weeks - In Person Instruction (June 24 - July 25, 2024)

WOHS: Monday - Thursday 8am-12pm

West Orange High School is implementing the fifth year of credit recovery for students with a final grade of an F in Algebra 1, Geometry, Algebra 2, College Math, all levels of English Language Arts, Social Studies, Science.

Students

This program is designed for students in grades 9 – 12 who have failed one or more core-courses and are seeking credit recovery.

Registration

The registration window for the WOHS Summer Institute 2024 is June 10 - June 21, 2024. Students must complete an online application by June 21st and can enroll for a maximum of 15 credits (3 courses). Students who need credit recovery will be contacted by their school counselor with registration information.

WOHS Summer Educere Supplemental Support

4 Weeks - Virtual Courses with In Person Support (June 26 - August 4, 2024)

West Orange High School students taking Educere courses for credit recovery are required to attend weekly Educere Supplemental Support classes.

They meet each Friday between 9:00am – 12:00pm.
(June 28th, July 12th, July 19th, & July 26th)

Students

This program is designed for students who have failed one or more core- courses and are seeking credit recovery through Educere.

Registration

The registration window for the WOHS Summer Educere Supplemental Support is June 10 - June 21, 2024. Students must complete their online application by June 21st. Course selections are to be completed with the guidance of the school counselor. Students will be contacted by their school counselor with registration information.

Social Emotional Learning, Grades 1-11

The SEL/Mental Health Program is designed to help students with developing the social and emotional skills necessary to succeed in and out of the classroom. The program seeks to create a culture of social and emotional learning, develop self-awareness and self-management skills to achieve school and life success; support students in using social-awareness and interpersonal skills to establish and maintain positive relationships; develop decision-making skills and responsible behaviors in personal, school, and community contexts.

The West Orange Summer Enrichment Program offers musical, artistic, and academic experiences which develop creativity, intellectual skills, and performing talents. Students may select courses that suit their abilities and interests.
