- A review of special education program design, curriculum, offerings, and program delivery with an emphasis on continuity of services across district schools
- A review of the district Autistic program
- A review of special education transition services



Description of Special Education Audit Services - continued

- A review of district facilities dedicated to the provision of special education services
- A review of the effectiveness of the co-teaching model being implemented across in-class support classrooms
- A review of special education student performance data
- An evaluation of home instruction services, supplemental instruction services, and special education transportation
- A review of related services
- A review of teacher, CST and support staff professional development activities and needs



Description of Special Education Audit Services - continued

- A review of special education technology services and software, including the implementation of IEP goals and objectives on a quarterly basis
- A review of district procedures to ensure non-discriminatory identification and evaluation
- A review of out-of-district placement data, including the feasibility of returning students to in-district programs
- A review of the district special education Master Scheduling process
- A review of teacher, CST and paraprofessional staffing patterns



Description of Special Education Audit Services - continued

- A review of any due process petitions and complaint investigations over the past 36 months
- A review of special education enrollment trends
- A review of the special education budget
- An review of special education instruction using walkthroughs
- Conduct forums with special education teachers and administrators, CST members, guidance counselors, related services staff, and parents in both English and Spanish
- Compilation of findings, development of recommendations, and presentation to the BOE/other audiences TBD
