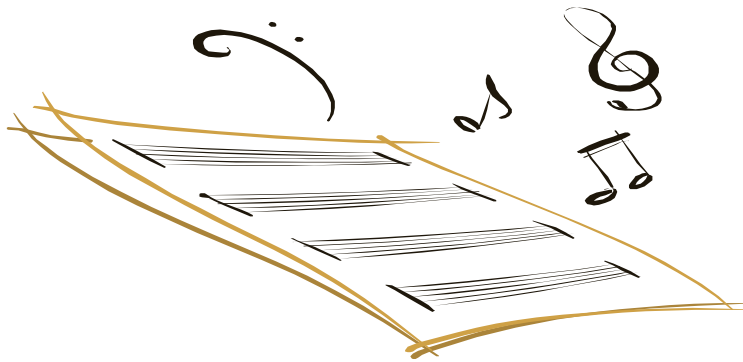

## **The West Orange High School Orchestra,**

under the direction of Dr. Elena Peres, is one of the premier string programs in the country. The Orchestra is an integral part of the West Orange Public School Music Department which has grown to offer string instruction to over 962 students annually.

The award winning WOHS Orchestra has performed at Carnegie Hall, Avery Fisher Hall and Alice Tully Hall at Lincoln Center in NYC, Disney World, Music in the Parks, Six Flags, Dorney Park and the West Orange Faculty Scholarship Concert which awards a scholarship to a graduating senior who is pursuing undergraduate studies in music education.

Members of the West Orange High School Orchestra have also performed with the renowned New Jersey Youth Symphony Orchestra, the Sussex County Youth Orchestra, New Jersey Region I Orchestra and the New Jersey All-State Orchestra.

In addition to large ensembles, high school students have an opportunity to be part of the chamber music program and work on advanced level literature. The students often perform at civic functions such as the Annual Mayor's Breakfast for the West Orange Chamber of Commerce, West Orange Rotary Club for St. Patrick's Day, and perform yearly at the Essex County Education Association's Pride in Education EXPO which features over 100 performing groups from Essex County.

The West Orange Public Schools District was nominated as one of the Top 100 Best Communities for Music Education in America by the National Association of Music Merchants (NAMM).

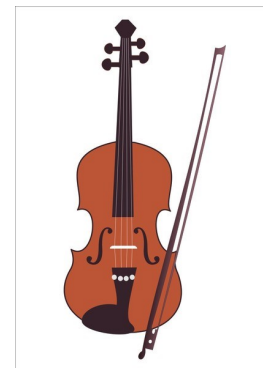
