If you are aware of any parents/guardians/caregivers that are not receiving communications from the district or from their school, we ask you to please advise them to consult with their school main office. The administration works consistently to improve communications, and any assistance in this endeavor is greatly appreciated.

Kindergarten Registration Survey

In an effort to refine the registration process for incoming kindergarteners, a <u>survey</u> is open to parents/guardians of current kindergarten students for submission of your feedback. Your valuable input will enhance the experience for future registrants and, as always, the district appreciates your participation.

PCR Test: Amidst the many different public health guidelines which both our staff and families are currently navigating, I'd like to clarify one point which I understand has been a source of some inconvenience and frustration for our families. In the event that you are asked to have your child tested either because of COVID related symptoms, close contact/exposure, or relative to the travel quarantine guidelines, please be advised that this must be a PCR test, a rapid antigen test is not acceptable. There are locations which can administer rapid PCR tests, though they are not common. A regular PCR test can take between two and three days for results.

District Master Calendar: In order to assist our schools and various community organizations in the planning and scheduling of events, as well as for the informational purposes of our community, we have begun to populate the digital district master calendar with a large number of events from the schools. We will continue to refine this <u>calendar</u> on the website and ensure that we are populating it with as many events as possible. This will ensure the greatest degree of coordination and avoid scheduling conflicts, as well as allow our community to have the opportunity to attend events districtwide.

The West Orange Department of Health vaccination clinic scheduled for tomorrow, <u>Saturday, October 16th at</u> 1:00 PM at Washington Elementary School has been cancelled.

The clinic scheduled for November 6th is still on, a second date is being planned for December 4th from 9:30-12:30. **1st and 2nd Doses of Pfizer COVID-19 Vaccine will be offered**. **Pre-Registration is now open** for those wishing to receive a first dose on October 16th.
