- Achieved athletic excellence during his or her tenure at West Orange High or Mountain High, or upon his or her graduation from high school.
- Has not brought dishonor upon either the high school or themselves.

LEFTY BOLAND OR COACHES AWARD:

A person may be elected if not a graduate of West Orange High School or Mountain High School if, in the opinion of The Committee, he or she has made significant contributions to the athletic programs of the Township's schools, or significantly supported, mentored and assisted town youth groups activities.

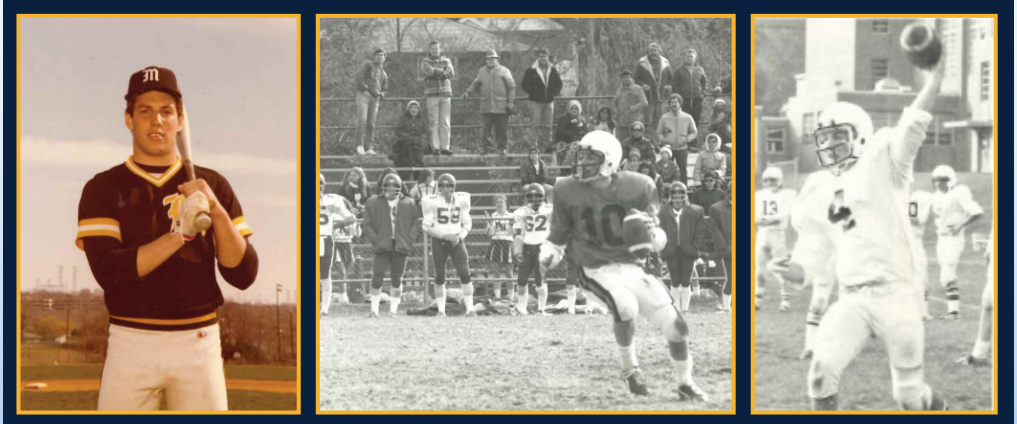

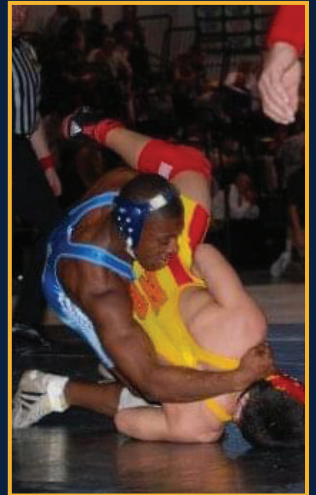
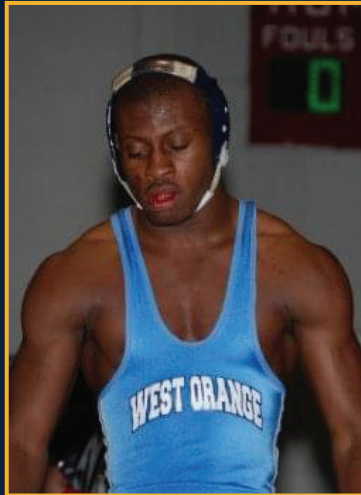

THE 2003 BOYS SOCCER TEAM

The 2003 Boys Soccer Team compiled a then school record 22 wins and went 22-2-2 that season. They won the schools first ever Essex County Tournament Title. In addition they won the school's first ever North I Group IV Sectional Title. They were led by captains Kyle Perdelwitz, Danny Siconolfi, Joe Tatalo and Matt Murphy.

In the state tournament, they defeated Livingston in the first round 4-2. They defeated Morristown in the second round 4-3 in OT. They defeated Emerson of Union City 2-1 on PK's, and then defeated Clifton 2-1 in the finals.

They were ranked Top 20 in NJ the whole season. They were ranked as high as 5th and finished the season ranked #10 in NJ.
