INSTRUCTIONS TO COMPLETE WORKING PAPERS:

- (A). <u>PERSONAL INFORMATION</u> To be completed by a Parent/Guardian. Social Security number and Signature are required.
- (B). <u>EMPLOYMENT INFORMATION</u> Must_be completed by your employer. Signature is required.
- (C). PHYSICIAN'S CERTIFICATE Must be completed by your physician with the date of examination.

 (For West Orange High students only) If you have completed a sports physical to play a sport, this section (Section C) can be completed by WOHS School Nurse.
- (D). PROOF OF AGE If you are a student at WOHS, proof of age is not required. All students not attending West Orange High School must present proof of age to the School Counseling Issuing Officer when returning completed working papers.
- (F). <u>SCHOOL RECORD</u> To be completed by the school the minor attends. Signature is required.
- (G). <u>ISSUING OFFICER CERTIFICATION -</u> To be completed and signed by a School Counseling Issuing Officer at West Orange High School. <u>THIS SECTION IS COMPLETED ONLY AFTER THE FORM IS FILLED OUT COMPLETELY AS INSTRUCTED ABOVE.</u>

You will be given the original white copy to return to your employer once the issuing officer has completed (G) and has assigned you a C.I.E.#.

RATE OF PAY FOR YOUNG WORKERS

Minimum Wage

Effective January 1, 2021, the New Jersey minimum wage rate is \$12.00 per hour.

A minor is entitled to a minimum wage in the following industries:

- Retail/Mercantile
- Food Service (Restaurant)
- Hotel/Motel
- Beauty Culture
- Laundry/Cleaning/Dyeing
- Light manufacturing apparel
- First process of farm products

Certain places are <u>not</u> required to pay minimum wage. Some examples are: <u>Nursing homes, Boardwalk and other seasonal amusements, Summer Camps, professional offices, and <u>libraries</u>. However, jobs related to food service in any of those places <u>must</u> pay the minimum wage. For example, an office worker in a nursing home can be paid less than the minimum wage; however, a dining room waitress in the nursing home must be paid minimum wage.</u>
