West Orange High School will be administering the PSAT/NMSQT (Preliminary School Aptitude Test/National Merit School Qualification Test) to all 10th and 11th grade students on **Wednesday**, **October 16, 2019.**

The PSAT helps students prepare for the SAT while qualifying high scoring juniors for entry into the National Merit Program. The test aligns with the SAT and provides students the opportunity to assess critical reading, mathematical reasoning, and writing skills needed for success in college and career. We expect all sophomores and juniors to take the PSAT as it gives WOHS, you and your child valuable feedback on strengths and weaknesses in the three testing areas.

It is essential for your child to become familiar with all that is included on the PSAT exam. To help prepare, students will receive a 2019 Official Student Guide to the PSAT/NMSQT in their English classes. This guide includes test-taking tips, National Merit Scholarship information, and a full-length practice test. In addition, you may visit

Test takers will come to school and board their bus at the regular time. WOHS will not be</u> <u>supplying calculators to students.</u> Room assignments will be given to all test takers one week prior to the test date.
