The ESL department at WOHS has identified a tremendous need for Math enrichment on the part of our English language learners. This school year, the demand for assistance in the area of math is more pronounced than ever before. In order to help increase the achievement of our students in this subject area, the ESL department is proposing the implementation of an afternoon program to run from December 7, 2010 through May 19, 2011. Students will receive assistance in the areas where they have expressed the most need, Geometry, Algebra 1 and 2, and Pre-Calculus. Presently, there are not LEP courses offered for these areas of math.

This program will consist of the following:

Students will be enrolled for one hour after school on Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays. This will allow student to take the "late bus" home.

It is projected that a program such as this will allow the LEP group to continue to make progress as per NCLB measurements. In the past two years, the LEP group percent passing improved from 9.1 to 37.9. While this represents movement in the right direction, the state sets an 85 as the target percent passing.

The cost of instructional salaries, materials, and supplies will be funded through Title III funds. Salaries for this program will total \$5890. This program will represent no cost to the West Orange School District.
