L. Adopt the following Code of Ethics as per N.J.S.A. 18A:12-21 et seq. and West Orange Board of Education Bylaw 9271.00:

The Members of the Board of Education recognize that they hold authority not as individuals but as Members of the Board. In order to make a clear public statement of its philosophy of service to the pupils of the District, the Board adopts this Code of Ethics:

- a. I will uphold and enforce all laws, rules and regulations of the State Board of Education, and court orders pertaining to schools. Desired changes shall be brought about only through legal and ethical procedures.
- b. I will make decisions in terms of the educational welfare of children and will seek to develop and maintain public schools which meet the individual needs of all children regardless of their ability, race, creed, sex or social standing.
- c. I will confine my board action to policy making, planning and appraisal, and I will help to frame policies and plans only after the Board has consulted those who will be affected by them.
- d. I will carry out my responsibility, not to administer the schools, but, together with my fellow Board Members, to see that they are well run.
- e. I will recognize that authority rests with the Board of Education and will make no personal promises nor take any private action that may compromise the Board.
- f. I will refuse to surrender my independent judgment to special interest or partisan political groups or to use the schools for personal gain or for the gain of friends.
- g. I will hold confidential all matters pertaining to the schools which, if disclosed, would

needlessly injure individuals or the schools. In all other matters, I will provide accurate information and, in concert with my fellow Board Members, interpret to the staff the aspirations of the community for its schools.

- h. I will vote to appoint the best-qualified personnel available after consideration of the recommendation of the chief administrative officer.
- i. I will support and protect school personnel in proper performance of their duties.
- j. I will refer all complaints to the chief administrative officer and will act on the complaints at public meetings only after failure of an administrative solution.

WHEREAS: The Board of Education desires to authorize its purchasing agent to make any and all purchases necessary to meet the needs of the school district throughout the school year; and

**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**: That the Board of Education does hereby authorize the District Purchasing Agent to make purchases of goods and services entered into on behalf of the State by the Division of Purchase and Property.

- P. Authorize the Purchasing Agent to utilize Educational Data Services, Inc. contracts for services and materials.
- Q. Authorize the Purchasing Agent to utilize the following agencies for services and materials:
  - Educational Services Commission of New Jersey
  - Essex Regional Educational Services Commission
  - Hunterdon County Educational Services Commission
  - Monmouth-Ocean Educational Services Commission
- R. Authorize certified school personnel to collect and maintain the following mandated pupil records as per N.J.A.C. 6A:32-7.3 and Policy 5125.00:
  - a. The student's name, address, telephone number, date of birth, name of parent(s), gender, citizenship, standardized assessment and test answer sheets (protocol), grades, attendance, classes attended, grade level completed, and year completed.

- b. Record of daily attendance;
- c. Descriptions of student progress according to the system of student evaluation used in the school district
- d. History and status of physical health compiled in accordance with State regulations, including results of any physical examinations given by qualified school district employees;
- e. Records pursuant to rules and regulations regarding education of students with disabilities; and
- f. All other records required by State Board of Education.
- S. In compliance with statutes and rules of the State Board of Education, approve the adoption of all existing Board-approved programs and services, curriculum, school objectives and Comprehensive Equity Plan goals until and unless revised by the West Orange Board of Education.
