

Kindergarten Supply List 2016-2017  
Please bring the first day of school (Sept.6<sup>th</sup>)

1. **Backpack – Full Size** (No Wheels).
2. **Crayons- 3 packs of crayons -24 count.** (Crayola brand preferred)
3. **Glue Sticks – 3 large sticks or 10 small.**
4. **Rest Time Mat** – Your child will need a rug or other small mat to use for rest time. Your child must be able to fold the mat into a square so that it fits in a cubby. (If it is too large it will be sent home.) (Some towels, and baby blankets work well. **Do not buy the plastic rest mats that are available in stores because they do not fit in our cubbies and will have to be returned to you.**)
5. **Smock** – Your child will need a smock (old adult oversized shirt) to cover his/her clothing for our Art activities. Be sure the smock fastens and is long enough to cover all clothing. **Do not buy the plastic smocks that are available in stores.**
6. **Hand Sanitizer OR Wipes** – Please send in either a pack of wipes **OR** a bottle of hand sanitizer for the entire class to use.
7. **Napkins-** 1 package of napkins which will be used during snack time.
8. **Snack** – A healthy snack must be brought to school every day.  
**HEALTHY-fruit, celery, carrots, cheese, crackers, granola bar, raisins, etc.**  
**NO JUNK FOOD- chips, cake, candy or soda will be sent home.**  
**NO GLASS BOTTLES.**  
PACK SNACK separately from his/her lunch and label with your child's name.
9. **Lunch** –Lunch is served beginning the first day of school (Tuesday, September 6).
10. **Sneakers** – Sneakers must be worn or brought to school on Physical Education days. You will be notified about which two days of the week your child will be attending Physical Education classes.

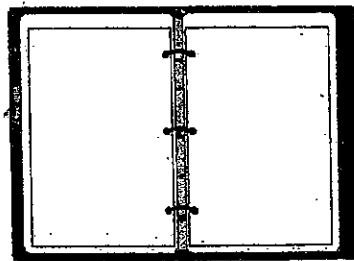
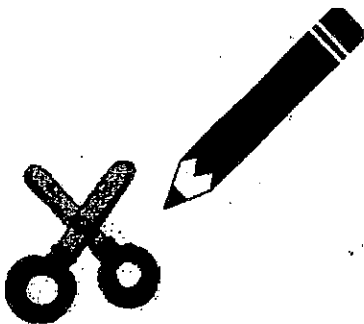
**Dear Parents,**
