Enrollment Form: Pesticide Application to Schools

In accordance to Public Act 99-165 "An Act Concerning Notice of Pesticide Applications at Schools and Day Care Centers," the West Orange School District is providing parents/guardians and staff the opportunity to be notified of pesticide applications.

The West Orange School District has adopted an Integrated Pest Management program (IPM). The primary goal of IPM is to reduce the amounts of pesticides applied by using alternative methods of pest control which may include structural maintenance, sanitation and mechanical, or biological control. These methods will help to eliminate conditions that are favorable to pest infestation, making their survival more difficult.

Each school will maintain a registry of persons requesting such notice. Prior to any required applications the school shall notify persons registered of (1) the date of the application, (2) the location of the application, (3) name of the active ingredient of pesticide applied, (4) name of the designated person who may be contacted for further information. This information will be kept at the school for a period of 5 years.

If and when the school district must use pesticide as a last resort, the applications will be done after school on a Friday. If you would like to be notified prior to a pesticide application, please complete the information below and return it to your school main office.
