<p>Unit 1 Sept.</p>	<p>Reading Unit 1 Students will be able to independently use their learning to become active members of a reading community who follow the routines and expectations, understand print concepts, and use listening skills to demonstrate comprehension of texts.</p> <p>Writing Unit 1 Students will be able to independently use their learning to become active participants in a writing community and follow workshop procedures.</p>
<p>Unit 2 Oct.</p>	<p>Reading Unit 2 Students will be able to independently use their learning to apply phonological awareness and comprehension strategies to recognize rhymes, isolate sounds, and understand the structure and meaning of fiction stories.</p> <p>Writing Unit 2 Students will be able to independently use their learning to write their own books using a pattern.</p>
<p>Unit 3 Nov.- Mid-Dec.</p>	<p>Reading Unit 3 Students will be able to independently use their learning to read and comprehend texts, identify key ideas, themes, and characters, use text features, make real-life connections, and build foundational literacy skills through rhyming, sound blending, syllable counting, and identifying consonants and short vowels.</p> <p>Writing Unit 3 Students will be able to independently use their learning to tell and write stories from their own lives through sketching and writing.</p>
<p>Unit 4 Mid-Dec. - January</p>	<p>Reading Unit 4 Students will independently use their foundational literacy skills, such as rhyming, sound isolation, and syllable blending, to read and understand informational and fictional texts by identifying key details, analyzing story elements, and making connections to enhance comprehension and critical thinking using text evidence.</p> <p>Writing Unit 4 Students will be able to independently use their learning to write and share an informational text about a topic they know well, using appropriate features of nonfiction writing and spelling strategies.</p>
