Unit	Unit Title, Link, and Transfer Goal
Unit 1 (20-30 days)	<p><u>Launching Reading Workshop</u> Students will be able to independently use their learning to establish positive reading habits and behaviors that ensure a productive learning environment which is conducive to supporting both reading stamina and independence.</p> <p><u>Launching Writing Workshop</u> Students will be able to independently use their learning to establish positive writing habits and routines that ensure a productive learning environment which is conducive to supporting independence and the writing process.</p>
Unit 2 (20-30 days)	<p><u>Print & Fluency</u> Students will be able to independently use their learning to establish print skills to decode and recognize words while developing fluency and monitor meaning to become proficient readers.</p> <p><u>Narrative: Small Moments</u> Students will be able to independently use their learning to write about small moments and real experiences in their lives so they can effectively communicate their thoughts and feelings in writing.</p>
Unit 3 (20-30 days)	<p><u>Experts in Nonfiction</u> Students will be able to independently use their learning to read nonfiction texts to learn about topics.</p> <p><u>Experts in Writing</u> Students will be able to independently use their learning to write an informational book about a topic of personal expertise that can effectively communicate to readers.</p>
Unit 4 (20-30 days)	<p><u>Fairy Tales, Folktales, and Fables</u> Students will be able to independently use their learning to understand the world of fairy tales, folk tales, and fables.</p> <p><u>Opinion Letters</u> Students will be able to independently use their learning to plan and write opinion letters about reading.</p>
Unit 5 (20-30 days)	<p><u>Fiction Series: Character Study</u> Students will be able to independently use their learning to read and think across books in a series by studying characters.</p> <p><u>Realistic Fiction Writing</u> Students will be able to independently use their learning to write realistic fiction stories that include all story elements (character, setting, problem, solution, beginning, middle, end).</p>
Unit 6 (20-30 days)	<p><u>Nonfiction Reading & Informational Writing in the Content Areas</u> Students will be able to independently use their learning to read to learn and write to teach about a content area topic.</p>
